E.C. rules apply

Passports, E.C., O.E.F. and Trillium memberships are required. Amateurs must present a current amateur status card.

Hard hats are compulsory. Hard hats with a harness must be worn in all classes over fences.

Proper footwear is mandatory as per E.C. rules.

No responsibility for accidents, loss, damage or theft can be assumed by any show management or staff.

Maximum height of fences for each division as per E.C. rules.

Hors Concours entries are only permitted in the Jumper Ring at the discretion of individual show management. Hors Concours Jumper entries may not participate in any jump off.

I hereby certify that every horse, rider and/or driver is eligible as entered and agree for myself and my representation to be bound by the Constitution and Rules of the Canadian Equestrian Federation at this competition.☐

It is hereby recognized that all equestrian sports involve inherent risk and that no helmet or protective equipment can protect against all foreseeable injury.
